



OFFICIAL KATS 2018 RULES & REGULATIONS: MIDWEST

OVERVIEW

The 2018 Midwest Kayak Angler Tournament Series will consist of 3 individual and 2 partnered(NO-MO, Border City Classic) tournament events..

A Midwest series-wide point system will be used to keep a running leaderboard based on individual event rankings. The KATS Midwest Angler of the Year Award will be given to the competitor with the most overall points from his/her best 4 out of 5 qualifying events. To be eligible, you must have participated in a minimum of 4 of the 5 events. Additionally, an award will be given to the King of the Fish, the angler with the 5 biggest eligible fish scored over the entire series..

We will make every effort to keep the 2018 KATS season a competitive and fun series regardless of your angling experience. We had great series over the last twelve years and look forward to yet another one!

IMPORTANT Information and Changes For 2018

We strive to make KATS the best kayak fishing tournament available. Thanks to all of you that have provided feedback and suggestions over the last few of years! While we try to accommodate as many wishes as we can, we are only able to enforce rules that make sense for the entire enterprise and that promote the growth of this group and the sport as a whole. Below are some changes that I encourage you to welcome to the 2018 KATS season, as I believe they will make it a more efficient, fairer, and even more enjoyable series of events!

- Kayak Angler of the Year eligibility will be based on the series leaderboard and 4 out of 5 events.
- King of the Fish will go to the angler with the 5 biggest fish scored over the entire series including the NO-MO and BCC. Only a maximum of 3 of the 5 fish may be from the NO-MO/BCC events.
- There may be several scheduled **Road-Runner** events, please see schedule and rules regarding roadrunners. There will also be pre-approved maps for acceptable launches during these road-runner events at fishkats.com.
- Meals/snacks will not be provided. Please plan accordingly.
- As a KATS competitor you are eligible for a discount in all Summit Sports stores, make sure to let them know when you checkout.
- We are fortunate and thankful to have as many sponsors as we do. Please make sure to show them your support. Complaints about free/donated prizes won in a tourney or in a raffle do not help our efforts in retaining those sponsors. If a prize doesn't suit your needs or you have no need for it, please return it to the staff so it can be raffled and donated to someone who will benefit from it. **Failure to follow this rule may result in immediate or future disqualification.**
- All KATS information is found on the KATS website: www.fishkats.com
- ALL registration will be through iAngler and will be prior to the event. We will no longer be offering day-of or onsite registration for various reasons (including but not limited to State and Federal laws, time constraints, and efficiency to get you out on the water)! MAKE SURE to SIGN UP ONLINE by the deadlines! This includes the purchase of any merchandise and raffle tickets benefitting the select charity.
- The Payout Structure is as follows: the Top 1st -5th places divide the cash (45/25/15/10/5%) and 6th-7th will earn sponsor gear prizes. The Social division payout structure will remain the same as 2017 and will win certificates with a value to be redeemed at ACK. For more details see Payout section in rules below.
- KATS Advantage- **Payout formula for 2018**. Anglers in the Pro Division will have the option to increase their entry fee to be entered into this program. For the extra \$50 you are entered in an **additional** payout option in which the top 20% of the Advantage field will be paid out. See below for some estimated payouts based on a number of entries. **100% Payout**

The KATS Advantage Payout is based on a algorithm that takes into account the total number of entries and calculates payouts in a fashion so that 20% of the Advantage field is compensated with at least their entry fee.

- Meet the **KATS Governing Body or KGB**. The KATS Governing Body is a representative group created by and for ACK/KATS to foster a sense of community and allow community anglers to voice opinion and input into the series. This informal group will meet regularly to discuss everything and anything related to KATS and the kayak fishing sport. Their duty will be to lead KATS in the best possible direction by leading efforts in series development, vision, and ongoing input. Our three newest members of the KGB for 2018 are located at the top!
 - **Craig Hefner**:- "Yellow Dog" - Look out for Craig's nice guy act, he takes no prisoners and will act like he needs all the help he can get. You have been warned! Craig will be part of the Hobie Fishing Worlds 7 in Amel, Sweden this spring.
 - **Lucian Gizel**: "Lucky Lucian" - With more than 15 years of experience in the sport, Captain Gizel was fishing out of a kayak long before it became popular in the Great Lakes Region. Lucian is also a Kayak Fishing Guide in the Metro Detroit Area and has participated in both saltwater and freshwater kayak tournaments over the last decade. ●
 - **Rich Ofner " Stogie"**: This Canadian angler who was the brainchild of the Border City Classic and countless years of kayak fishing experience. Rich brings a tremendous amount of experience to the KATS Midwest board and will be the voice of calm in the sea of tourney decisions.
 - **Chris LeMessurier**: "Guy" - Chris sometimes tries to play a little hockey in the winter. A long time kayak angler in Michigan and creator of the KFGL Forum and Facebook Group. His NO-MO Fishing Event is the longest running and largest Kayak Fishing event in Michigan.
 - **Noah O'Reilly**: "Fish Stick" - Noah represents a young group of kayak anglers that will make things tough for the older more experienced anglers.
- 2017 KATS Midwest charity fundraising efforts will benefit the following charity groups: Blessings in a Back Pack
- Launch and first cast times will be given during the 7 pm Captains Meeting on FB Live on Thursday night before events. Anglers may not fish or have any lines in the water prior to that designated time. You are responsible for knowing your launch/first cast time and violators will be disqualified.

2018 Rule Changes/Addendum

(Any new, altered, or otherwise changed rules/items for 2018 KATS season will be listed here as they are approved by the KATS Governing Body.)

- Pre fishing or practice period from a **POWER BOAT**, not a motorized kayak, is **PROHIBITED** for **TWO** weeks before the event.
- In addition to the **HAWG TROUGH**, the Yak-Gear **FISHSTIK** will also be an approved measuring device.
- The individual's names who place in both divisions, Pro and Social, will be removed from the General Raffle. This includes those who win prizes in lieu of a payout.
- There will be Mandatory Captains Meetings to be watched via Facebook Live and all anglers are responsible to clearly understand the posted rules or any changes or clarifications posted on KATS-Midwest Event Page prior to tournament start.
-
- Designated Launches are announced for roadrunners at start of season as well as maps that show approved launching locations.
- KATS reserves the right to use polygraph test at anytime throughout the season and reserves the right to disqualify an angler from that event based on a failed or inconclusive polygraph test. The runner up will either automatically take the win or be liable to also take and pass polygraph test. Points are forfeit for the event if disqualified. NO refunds or compensation of any kind will be provided as a result of a failed or inconclusive polygraph.

TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR'S NOTES:

First, we want to personally thank you for participating in this year's KATS season! I am proud to say that this is one of the largest and most organized kayak fishing tournament communities in the world. This is ACK's seventh year of owning/operating the KATS competition series. We are very thankful for the participation and support you have given us over the last few seasons and we hope you will love this season! Here are a few thoughts on what you can do on your part to help make this a smooth season.

- Please read the rules carefully and be familiar with them.
- Please note that only the PRO division will earn series points towards Kayak Angler of the Year. If you switch divisions you will only earn points for the tournaments you compete in the Pro division. There are no requirements for changing divisions. Pick your division based on entry fee, the payout/prize structure that appeals to you most, your desire to take a chance at competing Kayak Angler of the Year, and your skill.
- Please be meticulous with your CPR process. We have provided a comprehensive guide to doing this the proper way.
- Please be on time, bring what you need, and make sure you have registered online.
- Darken the ruler lines on your hawg trough with a sharpie.
- We are fortunate and thankful to have as many sponsors as we do. Please make sure to show them your support. Complaints about free/donated prizes won in a tourney or in a raffle do not help our efforts in retaining those sponsors. If a prize doesn't suit your needs or you have no need for it, please return it to the staff so it can be raffled and donated to someone who will benefit from it. **Failure to follow this rule may result in immediate or future disqualification.**
- Keep in mind that KATS is not a moneymaker for ACK or the KGB. KATS costs more to put on and manage than it brings in and it wouldn't be possible without the help of our sponsors, volunteer staff, and community members. Please help make KATS possible by supporting sponsors and ACK by choosing them for your outdoor gear needs.
- **Have fun, after all that's why we are all really there! Leave the profanities, drugs and alcohol, cheating and any other unsportsmanlike conduct elsewhere - it will not be tolerated!**

GENERAL RULES/DEFINITIONS

PARTICIPATION AND ELIGIBILITY

- The Series is open to ALL anglers provided they meet the Requirements and honor all Rules and Regulations listed below.
- There are NO membership fees or dues aside from individual event registration fees and optional side pots or raffle tickets.
- Disabled or Special Medical Needs: Competitors will be allowed to use kayaks or canoes with maximum of 12V trolling motors, or Kayak Manufacturer Motors, for competitions with prior approval from Tournament Director.
- TD reserves right to seek verification such as a doctor's note. Please contact the TD with ample time(see below) to make these arrangements.
- Competitor must provide a medical athletic exemption note from licensed physician notifying that the competitor qualifies for a temporary exemption and may use a motorized kayak due to disability, health risks, and other medical situations that otherwise impair the ability to participate in a standard paddling event. Exemption note must include a time period of exemption not to exceed the current season (a new note will be required for subsequent seasons).
- Exemption Form to be found on www.fishkats.com and must be submitted at least 2 business days prior to event.

LIABILITY RELEASE/LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

- ALL competitors must agree to a liability release prior to start of the event, this will be completed during your online registration.
- ALL competitors UNDER the age of 18 must provide a liability release signed by a parent or guardian before the start of the event. Parent or guardian must be present. This will be completed during your online registration.
- ALL competitors MUST have a valid Michigan Freshwater Fishing License or be exempt under DNR regulations.

APPROVED WATERCRAFT

- ONLY human powered vessels will be allowed.
- Kayaks, canoes, rowboats, inflatable boats, paddleboats, stand up paddleboards are acceptable.
- A "Blue Sky Boatworks Catamaran" is an approved vessel that can be used to participate in KATS.
- NO gasoline or electric motor propelled boats, sail boats, airboats, float tubes, or poled boats may be used.
- Only ONE paid entrant per vessel.
- NO pier/shoreline/wade/jug/trot line/hand line/cast or drag net/bow fishing allowed.
- See disability exception above for motorized vessels.

LAUNCH POINT

- ALL competitors must launch from shore at designated launch spot.
- ALL competitors will launch at designated launch time.
If a tournament is designated as "Roadrunner" event:
Boats may be launched at any legal and public launch site on the boundary waters of that particular event.
- Competitors will be given a first cast time at the Facebook Live Captains meeting. You may not have any lines in the water or be fishing prior to this time.
- Transporting vessels/competitors via power driven boats (including towing) is strictly prohibited except in the case of an emergency as determined by the tournament director.

PERMITTED FISHING METHODS/BAIT/LURES

- ONLY artificial baits/lures/flyes and hand-tied flies will be permitted.
- NO live or dead bait may be used.
- Rod and Reel and Fly Rods are the only devices acceptable.
- NO downriggers allowed, trolling under human power is acceptable.
- Wade Fishing as well as exiting the kayak to land a fish is PROHIBITED, if you need to exit the kayak for safety reasons or restroom breaks this is still permitted, NOT to land fish.
- 1 rods/line in the water at anytime with a maximum of 1 trolling at any time, or 1 in angler's hands at any time.

SAFETY REGULATIONS

- A 360 Light is required under DNR regulations when fishing 30 minutes before sunrise or 30 minutes after sunset or anytime in between and will be required when our launch times fall under these guidelines. **Supernovas or LED light strips DO NOT meet these requirements.** You will be held back for launch or DQ'ed if launching without a 360 light prior to safe light.
- PFD (lifejacket) MUST be worn at ALL times while on the water. NO exceptions. Violators will be immediately disqualified if spotted not wearing a PFD.
- Competitors must meet all DNR regulations.

- Competitors must meet all US Coast Guard Regulations.

- Summit Sports official spotters will be present during competitions.

GENERAL RULES

- NO competitors are to be within 10 yards of each other during fish-time; except in the case of emergency when assistance is required.
- NO fish are to be kept on stringers.
- Any ONE fish can only be submitted ONCE.
- Must view Captains Meeting on Facebook Live and know any clarifications or rules changes mentioned. Will be posted on Kayak Angler's Tournament Series - Midwest Page..

COMMUNICATION

- Any angler caught communicating with another angler/person during the event that violates the spirit of competition will be investigated and possibly disqualified from that event and/or future KATS - Midwest events.

QUALIFYING FISH

- ALL fish must be caught within boundary waters during the tournament time.
- ONLY the following species will count towards your total.
- Largemouth Bass, Smallmouth Bass

- CPR: Catch, Photo, and Release alive only.

MEASURING DEVICE

- The Hawg Trough and the Yak-Gear FISHTIK Ruler are the only acceptable measuring devices for all KATS events.
- Competitors must use their own measuring device (no sharing).
- Your device may be checked by KATS Midwest staff at any time.
- If the judge cannot clearly see the markings, that fish will not be scored. **At a minimum ¼ inch increments need to be visible. Consider marking your lines with a black sharpie on the Hawg Trough or FishStik.**
- Mouth Open for Social and Closed for Pro to Furthest Tip of Tail
- See “CPR How-to Guide” online and examples of acceptable photos

PRACTICE PERIOD/OFF LIMITS

- Pre fishing or practice period from a POWER BOAT, not a motorized kayak, is PROHIBITED for TWO weeks before the event.
- Fishing in OFF-LIMITS areas will result in disqualification. OFF -LIMITS areas are defined as but not limited to any and all areas marked by buoys , signage, or barriers with the intent of keeping people out. Any posted, legal, private property, or otherwise off limits areas plus any specific areas as determined by KATS staff are strictly OFF-LIMITS to anglers. **Anglers may NOT fish, cast a line, or be in the off-limits areas.**
- 30 Day OFF limits of hiring guide services from DAY OF tournament. Ex: If event takes place on 1/31. Guide Services are OFF limits after 12/31, 11:59pm

RESCHEDULING/CANCELLATION/NON-ATTENDANCE

- INCLEMENT WEATHER: The Tournament Director may delay, reschedule, or cancel the event.
- The first option will be a delay to be determined by the tournament director.
- The reschedule date for any event is the following day (same time/place/launch).
- If both days are rescheduled, the following weekend will serve as make-up event.
- If canceled or rescheduled, entrants can be refunded or have fee applied to next event.
- No refunds for prepaid entrants will be given for non-attendance regardless of the reason.

PHOTO RELEASE

- Contestants grant AKF and ACK and the sponsors the unconditional right to use their name, voice, photographic likeness and biographical information in connection with AKF and ACK tournaments, production, promotion, and/or articles and press releases, and shall not be entitled to receive any royalties or other compensation in connection with such use.

IMPAIRMENT

- DRUG and ALCOHOL use during the tournament is strictly PROHIBITED.
- ANY competitor found to be under the influence will be disqualified and will receive a score of ZERO.

RULES INTERPRETATION and PROTESTS

- All rules are decided and interpreted by the Tournament Director.
- Any protests should be registered with the tournament director immediately after the results being posted.
- The Tournament Director retains the right to make any changes at ANY time, and the FINAL decision.
- Not having read the rules is NOT an exception.
- Tournament director may consult with the KGB members for any rulings as needed and determined by TD.

SPECIAL RULES

- Each event is liable to have special rules. They will be posted under the Special Rules section on the KATS page.
- All necessary information will be posted prior to event.

SPORTSMANSHIP

- The KATS competition is intended and will be a competitive and professional event. It is also designed to be lots of fun. That being said, ALL anglers are encouraged to be good sportsmen throughout the series. **Any disorderly conduct, violation of rules, illegal activity or disregard for the KATS Code of Conduct may result in your disqualification.**
- Any report of cheating will be investigated. Any cheating reported with proof will result in immediate disqualification. KNOW THE RULES!
- We reserve the right to polygraph anyone entering in the KATS tournaments to determine foul play. We also reserve the right to disqualify anyone from the results of the tests including inconclusive test results.

DIVISIONS/ENTRY FEES/PAYOUT

DIVISIONS

- **KATS is a TWO division series:**
- The Pro division is geared towards the experienced “veteran” kayak angler that is confident competing against the best of the best in the area. This is where we track series points and you earn your way into Kayak Angler of the Year, and King of the Fish.
- The Social division is geared towards the semi-experienced or the “newbie”. You are participating not only for a competitive non-cash certificate prize but also fun and good times. You are not interested in competing for Kayak Angler of the Year. Any size bass counts.
- Please see the rules for more details on prize payout, structure, etc.
- PRO Division (You Do Not have to be a professional to fish this division)
- SOCIAL Division (The Social Division is not eligible for series points or Angler of the Year.)
- There are no requirements for moving up in divisions based on performance.
- If you move up from Social to the PRO division, you will only accumulate series points from that point forward.

ENTRY FEES

- ALL participants MUST have paid entry fee prior to fishing.
- Entry Fee for this KATS season is as follows:
- Entry will be paid online by deadline posted:
Online Registration will end on the Thursday night prior to Tournament.
 - Pro Division \$75 (Big Bass included)
 - Social \$50 (Big Bass included)
 - Border City Classic \$110 (Big Bass included)
 - \$5 of your PRO entry fee for each event goes towards KATS Midwest Angler of the Year Payout.
 - \$50 of Pro entry fee goes to cash payout.
 - \$30 of Social goes toward prize payout(non-cash).
 - Big Bass is included. Each competitor is automatically entered for \$10 value into Big Bass Payout for each event (all divisions).
 - KATS Angler Advantage is optional. Each competitor is able to put \$50 into this additional payout program.

- The remainder (\$10) is applied to sign up costs, prizes and supplies, staffing and the costs associated with these events.
- Breakdown Review:
 - PRO \$75 = \$5(classic reserve payout) +\$50 (immediate payout) +\$10 (immediate big bass payout) + \$10 (to cover costs)
 - SOCIAL \$50 = \$30 (immediate payout) +\$10 (immediate big bass payout) + \$10 (to cover costs)
 - Border City Classic \$110 = see BCC for payout schedule

PAYOUT

- **PRO Division Payout Schedule:**
 - **The cash prize pot will be divided as follows:**
 - Total cash pot will go to 1-5th places
 - 45-25-15-10-5% payout
 - 6th and 7th place will be Sponsor gift cards/prizes
- **SOCIAL Division Payout Schedule:**
 - Prize money (prize pot) will be awarded in the form of ACK (Austin Canoe and Kayak) gift certificates. This allows you to have more flexibility in choosing the gear you want for your winnings.
 - 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Places Payout 55-30-15%
 - 4th and 5th will win vendor gear
 - 4th payout for 30-39 anglers (in your division)
 - 5th payout for 40+ anglers (in your division)
- **Big Bass Pot**
 - Competitor with biggest bass wins entire prize. Ties are determined by standard tie criteria. Each event has its own Big Bass.
- **KGB Mystery Tackle Bag**
 - Enter (\$5) for your chance to win a gift card (value of all Mystery entries - 100% payout) to TackleWarehouse.com. Sign up is offered online during registration. Both the PRO and Social division are allowed to sign up and qualify to win. One winner, take all, at the end of each tournament.

PHOTO CRITERIA/SUBMISSION/JUDGING

APPROVED CAMERAS

- Your PERSONAL DIGITAL CAMERA only.
- NO camera phones, disposable or film cameras are allowed.
- You MUST provide whatever cables, cords, software, etc required to download photos via a USB port to judge's laptop.
- While we have a universal card reader, it is highly recommended that you bring a USB cord that is compatible with your camera. It is **YOUR** responsibility to make sure we can download your pictures.

PHOTO CRITERIA

- See the info graphic on proper CPR process.
- Each fish photo MUST include ALL of the following criteria:
 - The whole fish, tip to tail.
 - Laying with the tip of the lip at beginning of hawg trough.
 - Mouth Open for Social and Closed for Pro to Furthest Tip of Tail

- Fish MUST be left side UP.
- Measurement markings must be clearly visible
- Assigned unique identifier must be visible
- ONE OVERHEAD PHOTO SHOT FRAME (not at an angle)
- Fish must be clear of any devices. Fins/tail/head cannot be obstructed in photo.
- ALL criteria must be met or photo will not be scored.
- Please avoid taking more than 2-3 photos of each fish.
- Consider using a numbering system.

SUBMISSION CRITERIA/PROCESS

- All KATS Midwest Tournaments will use the iAngler app to log catches
- Your PERSONAL DIGITAL CAMERA, or Camera Phone are acceptable
- You MUST provide whatever cables, cords, software, etc required to download photos via a USB port to judge's laptop.
- While we have a universal card reader, it is highly recommended that you bring a USB cord that is compatible with your camera.
- It is YOUR responsibility to make sure we can download your pictures.
- **Memory cards are to be clear of any photos prior to event.**
- ONLY fish scoring pictures submitted. EX: No birthday or graduation pictures on memory card. Only scorable pics will be accepted!
- A maximum of 2 pictures can be turned in for each fish. Make sure they are quality before releasing the fish. The Judge will choose your best photo for each fish.
- If ANY criteria are not adhered to, your photo may not be scored at all, or be penalized with a 6" subtraction from your TOTAL score.
- KATS is not responsible for failed or corrupt files.

WEIGH IN

- ALL competitors **must be** in line at weigh in by the designated time. All competitors must have on them the following items: camera, memory card, and USB cable for camera.
- **ONLY** the Tournament Director and AKF designated staff will be involved in the judging process.
- Once you turn in your memory card, **please move away from the area until called.**
- LATE CHECK-IN will be permitted until **15** minutes after end-time; however, a penalty of 1" per every 5 minutes will be deducted from the competitor's total.

JUDGING

- Competitor photos will be reviewed and scored by Tournament Director and AKF designated staff.
 - Photos that do not meet the requirements as provided will **not** count.
 - The Tournament Director and AKF staff will be solely responsible and retain the right to declare any photo as "unacceptable".
- Winners will be declared and prizes/awards will be announced by the Tournament Director.
- The Tournament will then be declared complete.
- Competitors may contest results up two 2 calendar days after event. Tournament Director will make final decision on whether adjustment will be made and which effect that will have on any prizes given out in the event of an error.

SCORING/POINTS/TIES/AWARDS

SCORING

- EACH competitor will be provided a unique identifier and given a scorecard for each event.
- Your 5 (five) LONGEST verified lengths will be totaled for your score.
 - Fish UNDER 14" will not be scored and should not be photographed or recorded.
 - A 14" bass is legal; a 13.5 in bass is not legal, no rounding will apply.
 - *** **SOCIAL division is any size bass counts*****
- The competitor with the HIGHEST total score is the WINNER. Next highest score will place second, and so on.
- Rounding will be DOWN and to the nearest ¼ (quarter) inch.
- Some permanent markers will be available (until supplies run out). **You are responsible for bringing your own, or returning the one you borrowed.**

TIES

- In the event of a TIE, the following criteria will decide the winner:
 - Biggest Fish
 - 2nd Biggest Fish
 - 3rd Biggest Fish
 - And so on until there are no more fish to compare; then a coin toss.

PRO SERIES POINTS ACCUMULATION

- A points system will be used to determine the overall SERIES RANKINGS.
- Each event will produce a ranking list scored as such:
 - 1st place-100 points
 - 2nd place-99 points
 - And so on for all competitors, however, you MUST catch at least one LEGAL fish to score any series points.
 - Competitors who do not catch any legal fish or who do not turn in a scorecard will score 0.
 - The Social Division is not eligible for series points.
- The Angler of the Year will be determined by a total score of your best 4 out of 5 event scores.
- A "King of the Fish" award will be given to the angler with the biggest 5 scored fish over the entire series (all events), along with a 2nd and 3rd place winner.
